Tracy Art League's annual regional juried art exhibit, EXPRESSIONS!, brings the finest work of Northern California artists to the community every February. Open to the public, without charge, the exhibit is supported by a partnership between TAL, City agencies, local businesses, and a staff of volunteers.

EXPRESSIONS! funds the League's annual scholarship program for High School students. TAL has been proud to help talented young people pursuing a degree in the arts to achieve their educational goals for over 30 years.

Unique to EXPRESSIONS! is its outreach to local children. The EXPRESSIONS! Children's Tour was adopted as a part of the arts curriculum of Tracy's schools, system-wide, augmenting the classroom programs. Nearly 3,000 children participate every year. The Tour is designed to develop critical thinking skills and give the children an in-depth introduction to fine art.
